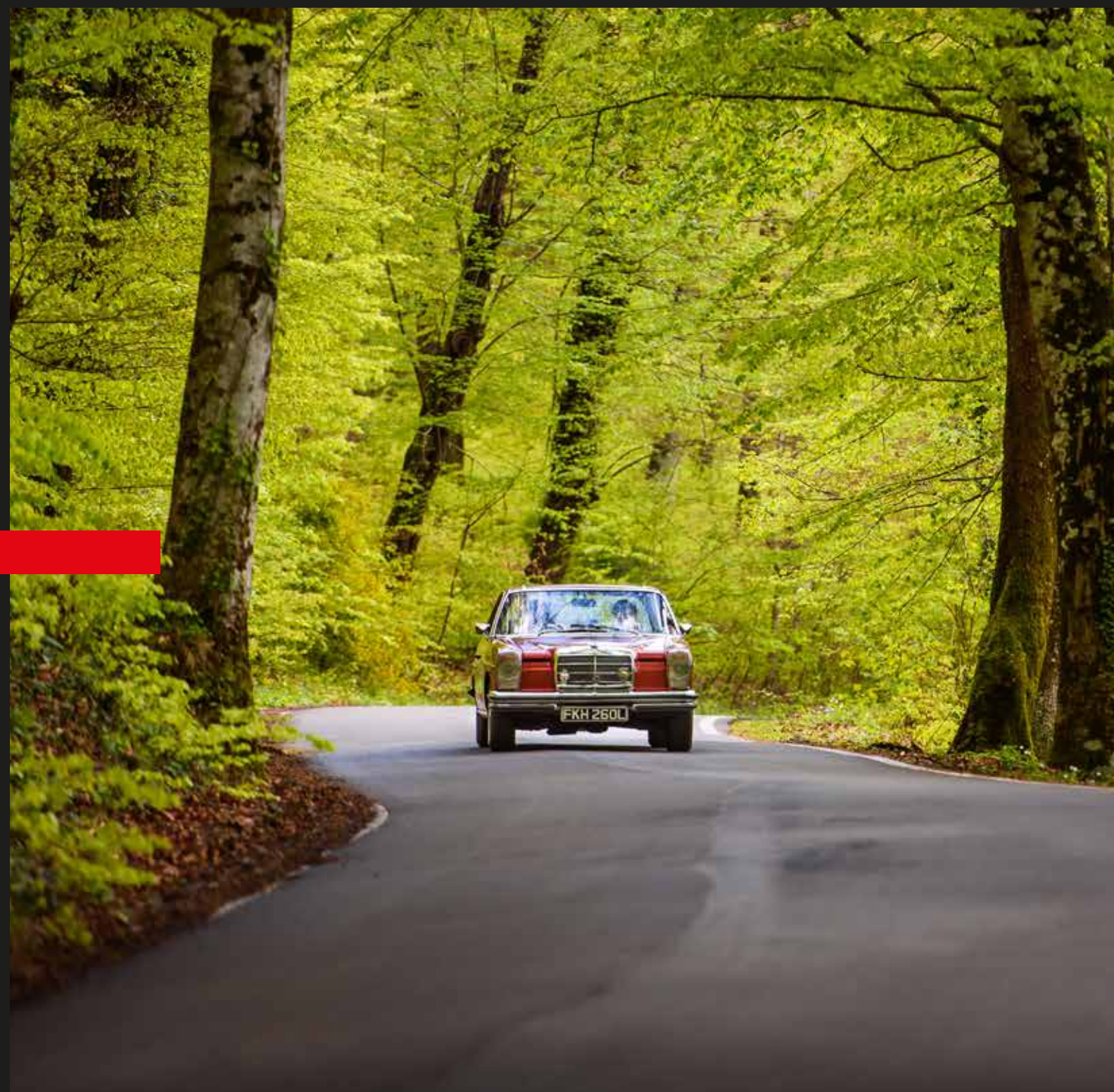

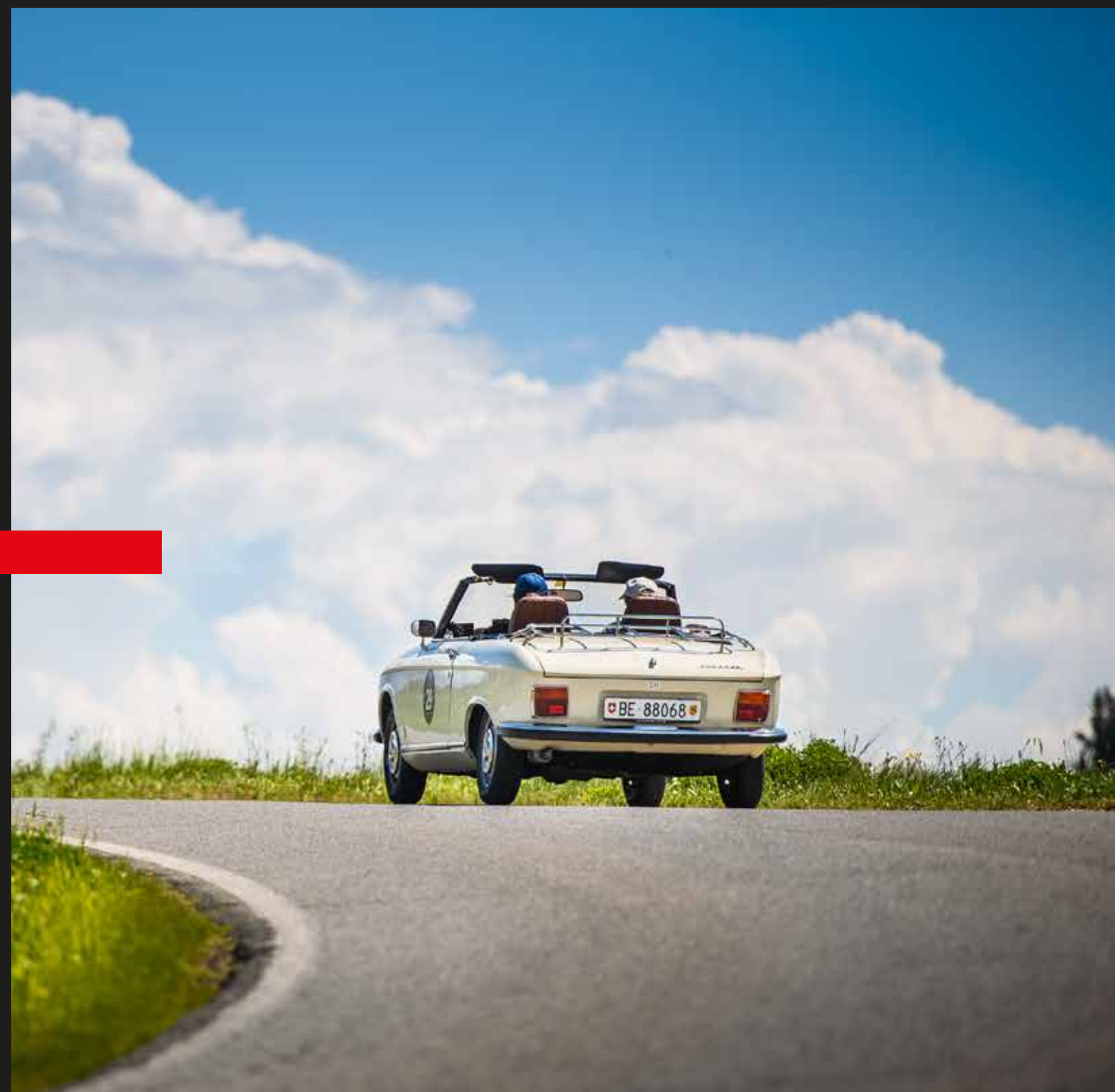
7TH Excellences of Modena

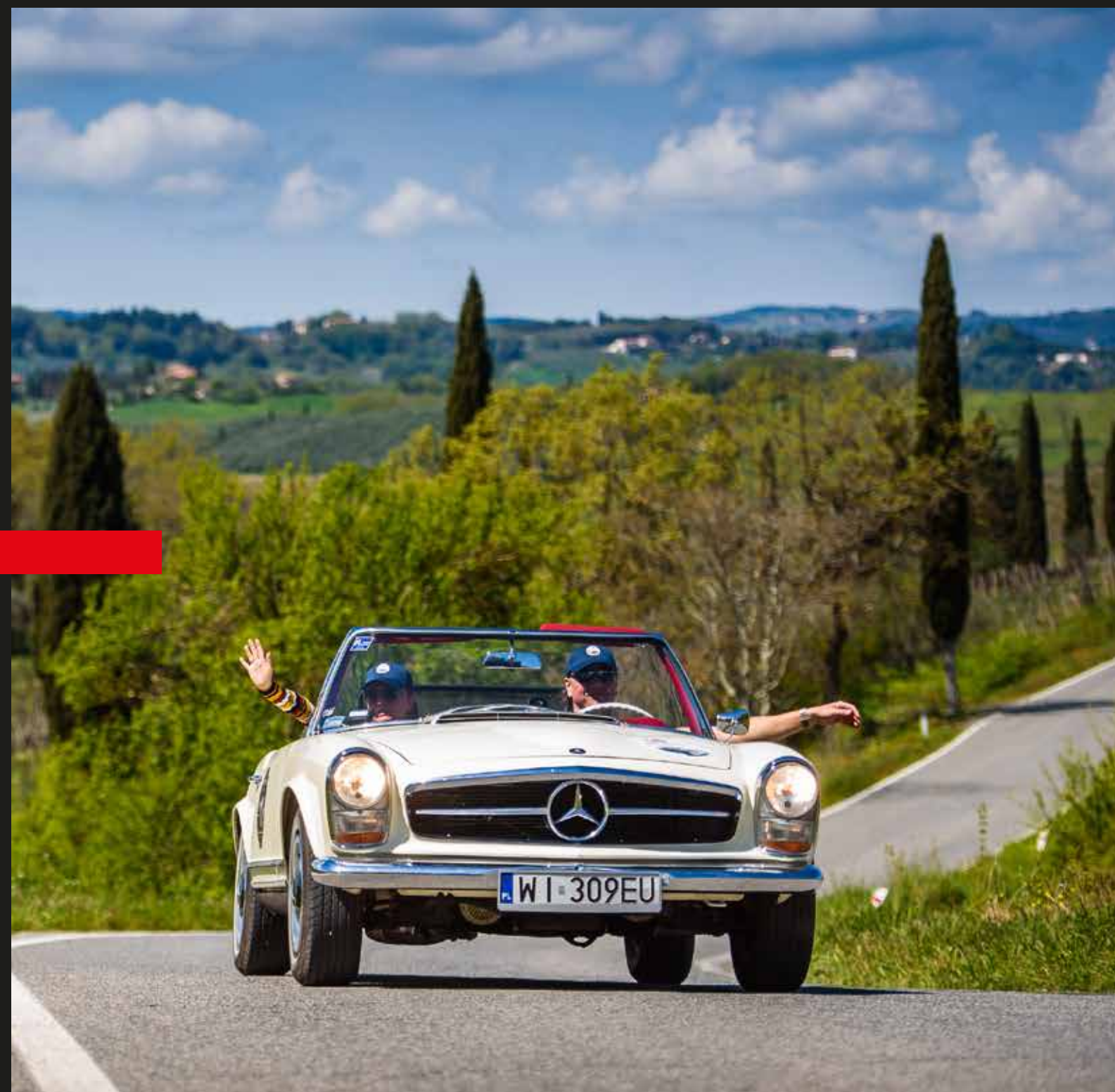




9TH Road to Portofino

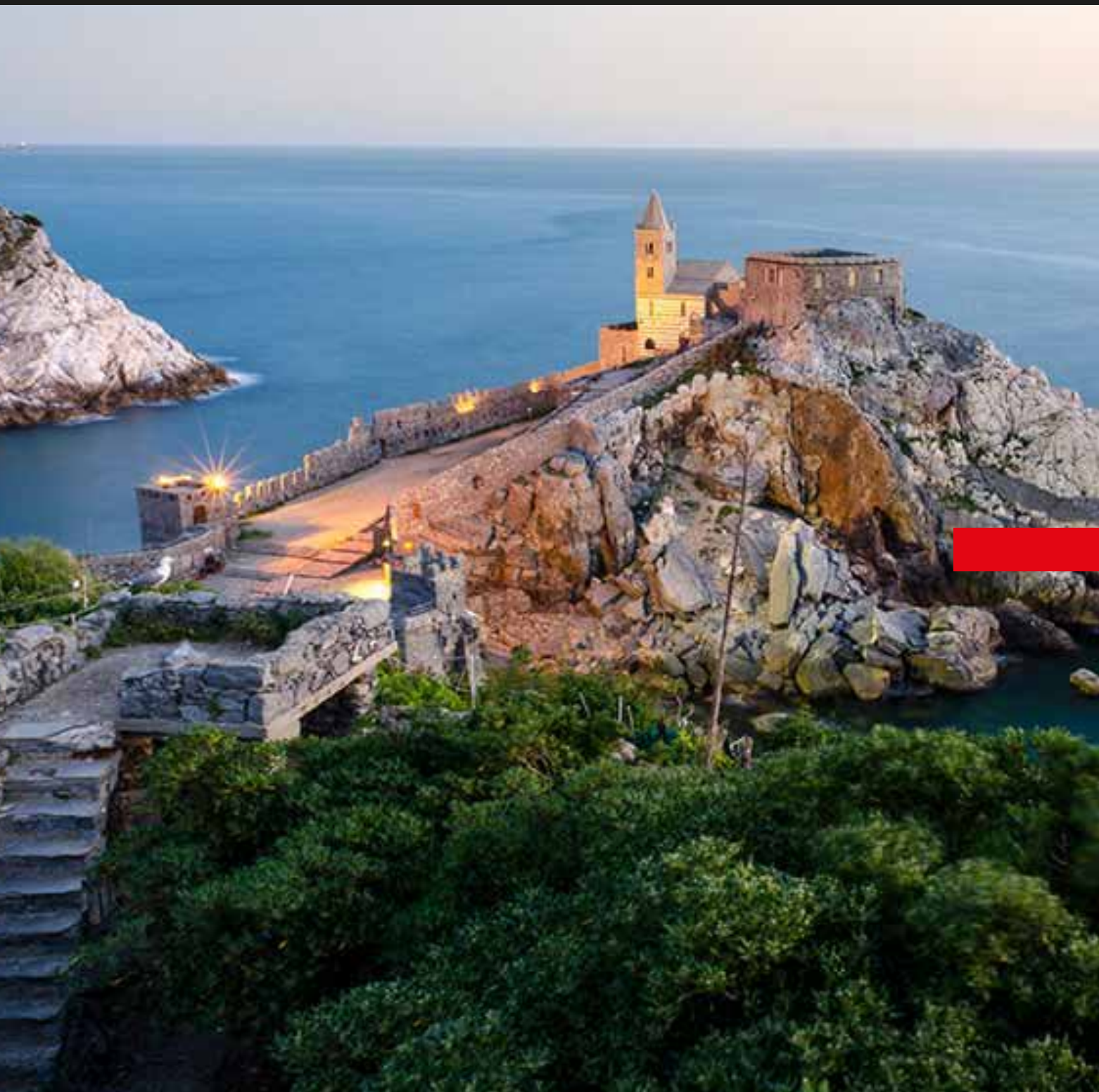


10TH 5 Terre and the amazing Riviera di Levante
